WHAT: Suzuki Early Childhood Education is a program developed by the Suzuki Association of the Americas that promotes not only a love of music but a love of learning. Children have unlimited capacity to care, share and learn. We believe that learning music should be a joyful experience. Our approach to teaching is based on the philosophy of Dr. Shinichi Suzuki – that talent can be taught and every child can learn. SECE focuses on a child's natural delight in learning and aims to develop the abilities and natural potential of each child through listening, modelling, encouragement, repetition and parental involvement.

Through songs, rhymes and activities, this Suzuki Early Childhood Education class will introduce your child to information and skills that will help develop his/her musical ear, language, focus, physical coordination, social skills and confidence. Various repertoire from the Suzuki method are presented during class, most often as a live demonstration on the cello or the violin. Students have the opportunity to try their hand at real fractional instruments as well. A reference recording with the songs from the class will be available for purchase. We encourage you and your child to listen to it as much as possible to get familiar with the songs.

WHO: Etobicoke Suzuki Music is a nonprofit, co-operatively run school, founded in 1982. It is recognized as one of the oldest and finest Suzuki programs in Canada.

- We follow the philosophy of Talent Education developed by Shinichi Suzuki in Japan in the 1940's. This philosophy is based on the idea that every child has the potential to achieve a high level of proficiency and personal development (see <http://essm.ca/method.asp> for more information).
- Instruction is carried out in a positive manner that reinforces accomplishments, builds confidence and is fun.
- The repertoire is designed to build skills in small sequential steps that are easy for young children.
- Children progress at their own pace.
- Faculty participate in ongoing teacher development sessions including regular pedagogy discussions as well as additional Suzuki Teacher Training, conferences and workshops.

Our faculty members have extensive and specialized training in the Suzuki method acquired in Canada, the US and Japan. Our teachers are all accomplished musicians and perform in various orchestras and ensembles. SECE classes are for young children, from birth through 4 years old, and their parent/caregiver.
The classes are small (8 or less children).

WHERE: PLAST Huculak Ukrainian Centre, 516 The Kingsway (at Kipling). Limited parking in front near ramp. More parking in rear (Kipling Ave side). All SECE classes take place on main level.

WHEN: Mondays 11:00am-12:00pm

DATES AND FEES: The class runs September 2017 to early June 2018 and will be grouped into **three 8 week sessions:** fall, winter and spring. There will be a **20%** discount given for siblings. Families who register for the whole year will receive an additional **10%** discount.

FALL SESSION: Mondays: September 25 - November 27 *** no classes October 9, 23***

WINTER SESSION: Mondays: January 8 - March 5 *** no class February 19***

SPRING SESSION: Mondays: April 9 - June 4 *** no class May 21***

Fee per term: \$180 (20% sibling discount \$144)

REFUNDS/CREDITS: We take new registrations throughout the year. Fees will be pro-rated for joining later in the year. If we have to cancel a class due to insufficient registration, you will receive a full refund. **ABSOLUTELY NO REFUND** will be granted **14 DAYS PRIOR** to the start of the session or once sessions have begun. **NO MAKEUP SESSIONS** will be offered for students who miss classes. Refund requests **BEFORE 14 DAYS PRIOR** to the start of the session will be granted in full, minus the \$25 administration fee. **FOR FULL YEAR REGISTRANTS:** After Session 2 begins, **NO REFUNDS** will be issued.
