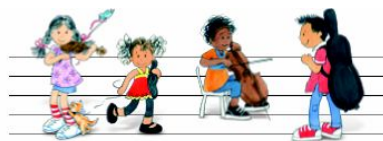
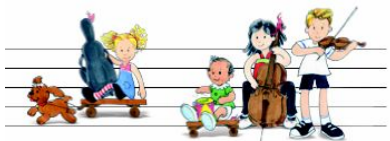
Please note: it is your responsibility to remove your child from events if you do not want them photographed.

WHAT: Suzuki Early Childhood Education (SECE) is a program developed by the Suzuki Association of the Americas that promotes not only a love of music but a love of learning. Children have unlimited capacity to care, share, and learn. We believe that learning music should be a joyful experience. Our approach to teaching is based on the philosophy of Dr. Shinichi Suzuki - that talent can be taught and every child can learn. SECE focuses on a child's natural delight in learning and aims to develop the abilities and natural potential of each child through listening, modeling, encouragement, repetition, and parental involvement.

Through songs, rhymes, and activities, this SECE class will introduce your child to information and skills that will help develop their musical ear, language, focus, physical coordination, social skills, and confidence. Various repertoire from the Suzuki method is presented during class, often as a live demonstration on the violin or cello. Students have the opportunity to try their hand at real instruments as well. A reference recording with the songs from the class will be available for purchase. We encourage you and your child to listen to it as much as possible to get familiar with the songs.

WHO: Etobicoke Suzuki Music (ESM) is a non-profit, cooperatively run school founded in 1982. It is recognized as one of the oldest and finest Suzuki programs in Canada.

- We follow the philosophy of Talent Education developed by Shinichi Suzuki in Japan in the 1940s. This philosophy is based on the idea that every child has the potential to achieve a high level of proficiency and personal development.
- Instruction is carried out in a positive manner that reinforces accomplishments, builds confidence, and is fun.
- The repertoire is designed to build skills in small sequential steps that are easy for young children.
- Children progress at their own pace.
- Faculty participate in ongoing teacher development sessions, including regular pedagogy discussions as well as additional Suzuki Teacher Training, conferences, and workshops.
- Our faculty members have extensive and specialized training in the Suzuki method acquired in Canada, the United States, and Japan.

SECE classes are for young children, from birth through 4 years old, and their parent/caregiver. Classes are small (8 children or less in each class).

WHERE: PLAST Huculak Ukrainian Centre, 516 The Kingsway (at Kipling). Parking is available in front near the ramp and at the rear (Kipling Avenue side). All SECE classes take place on the main level.

WHEN: Monday mornings from 9am - 10am.

DATES/FEES: The class runs Mondays until June 2019 for a 10 week-long spring session. Siblings are given a 20% discount. Families who register by the earlybird deadline will receive an additional 10% discount.

SESSION DATES

April 1 - June 17 (no class April 22 or May 20)

Fee per term is \$225. 20% sibling discount is **\$180.** Save 10% off with earlybird pricing!

Earlybird deadline to register is **Friday March 15th** for the spring term.

REFUNDS: We take new registrations throughout the year. Fees will be prorated for joining later in the year. If a class needs to be cancelled due to insufficient registration, you will receive a full refund. Absolutely no refund will be granted 14 days prior to the start of the term or during the term. No makeup sessions will be offered for students who miss classes. Refund requests before 14 days prior to the start of the term will be granted in full, minus the \$25 administration fee.
